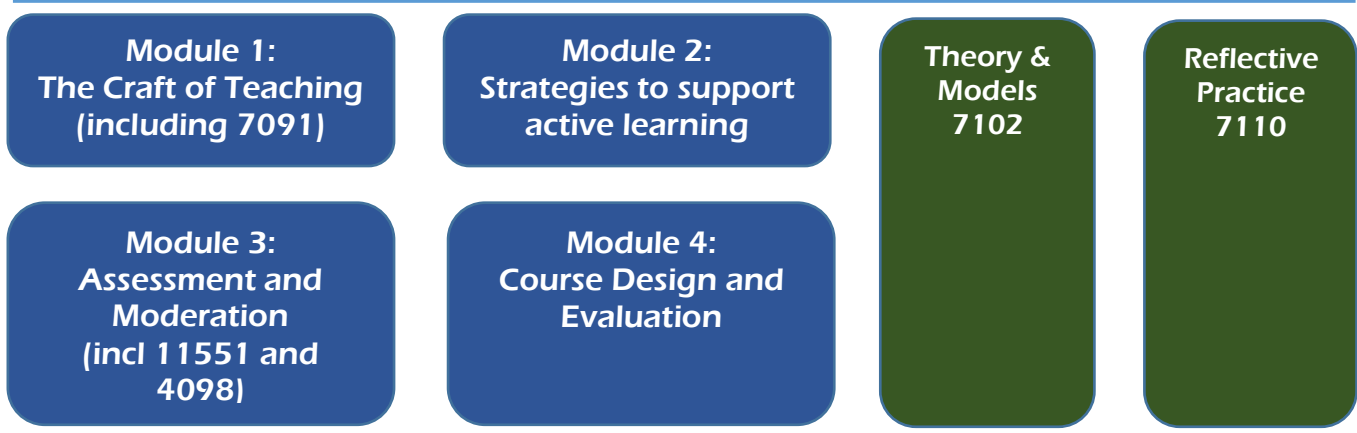


National Certificate in Adult Education and Training (NCAET) Summer 2016 and 2017

Usually you would do things in this order:

Introduction ▶ Module 1 ▶ Start 7102 ▶ Module 2 ▶ Start 7110 ▶ Module 3 ▶ Module 4 ▶ Wrap-up ▶ Party.
7102 and 7110 can be done as standalone units or as part of the Modules.

Frequently asked Questions

<p>If I want to enrol or need more information, what do I do? Talk to your manager and call me.</p> <p>Is there anything I can do over the summer? Yes. It is possible to start on various units, for instance 7091 or 7102.</p> <p>Do I need a class to teach? Yes. For the whole NCAET you will. But you can start on some units that do not require a class.</p>	<p>I've already started and have some units, what is the next step? Get a copy of your Record of Learning to me. We can make a plan.</p> <p>I need 4098 (or 11551) now. Can I do this? Yes. We are experimenting with 4098 online now.</p> <p>Can I just pick a few courses? Yes. If you want a refresher, then try Module 2 or Reflective Practice.</p>	<p>What work is involved? Most of the actual time is on the job. You have reflections, assignments and other course work. Some of this is online.</p> <p>What time is involved? Some day workshops, and weekly sessions either online or in groups.</p> <p>What is the assessment like? Most of this is based around action and reflection in your real classes. Some is more like portfolio assessment.</p>
